

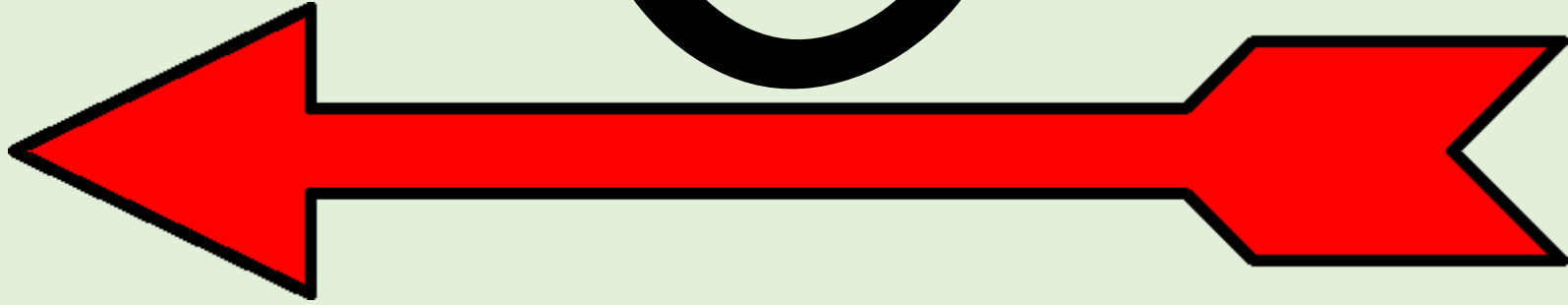

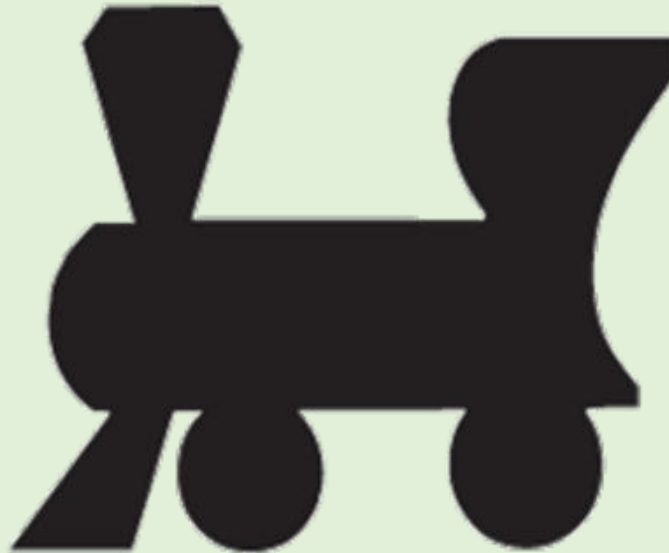

# LOTTERY NUMBER

Once students apply for housing, everyone is broken into categories based on completed units as of January 1<sup>st</sup>.

These categories are:  
Graduate Students and  
Rising Seniors, Rising  
Juniors, and Rising  
Sophomores.

The lower  
the number,  
the better!

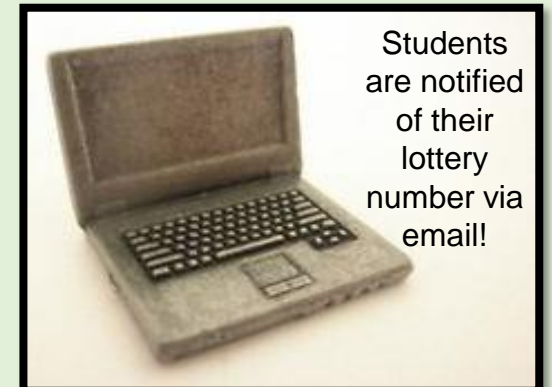
Lottery numbers are then randomly assigned per category. Lottery numbers have no correlation to a students' registration status with class selection.

Lottery numbers are as follows:  
Graduate Students- 001-400  
Rising Seniors- 001-400  
Rising Juniors- 401-800  
Rising Sophomores- 801-1300

*If a student believes they are in the wrong class assignment, they will have the opportunity to appeal it.*



Students are notified of their lottery number via email!

# SELECTION NIGHT: WHAT HAPPENS?

- Students come to their appropriate housing selection night beginning at 5pm each night
- Students must have a completed *Housing Group Form* once they arrive on housing selection night
- While students wait, available rooms will be projected so students can track what rooms are available
- Lottery numbers will be called and students will meet with ResEd staff members who will place the students. Students will have 30 seconds to select the room they want once they are meeting with the ResEd staff members
- For groups, the student with the lowest lottery number picks for the entire group (note: this only would occur if all students in a group are eligible to select)
- Once students have picked their housing, they are good to go!

A1, A2, A4, B6, C1, C4, C6, & E1

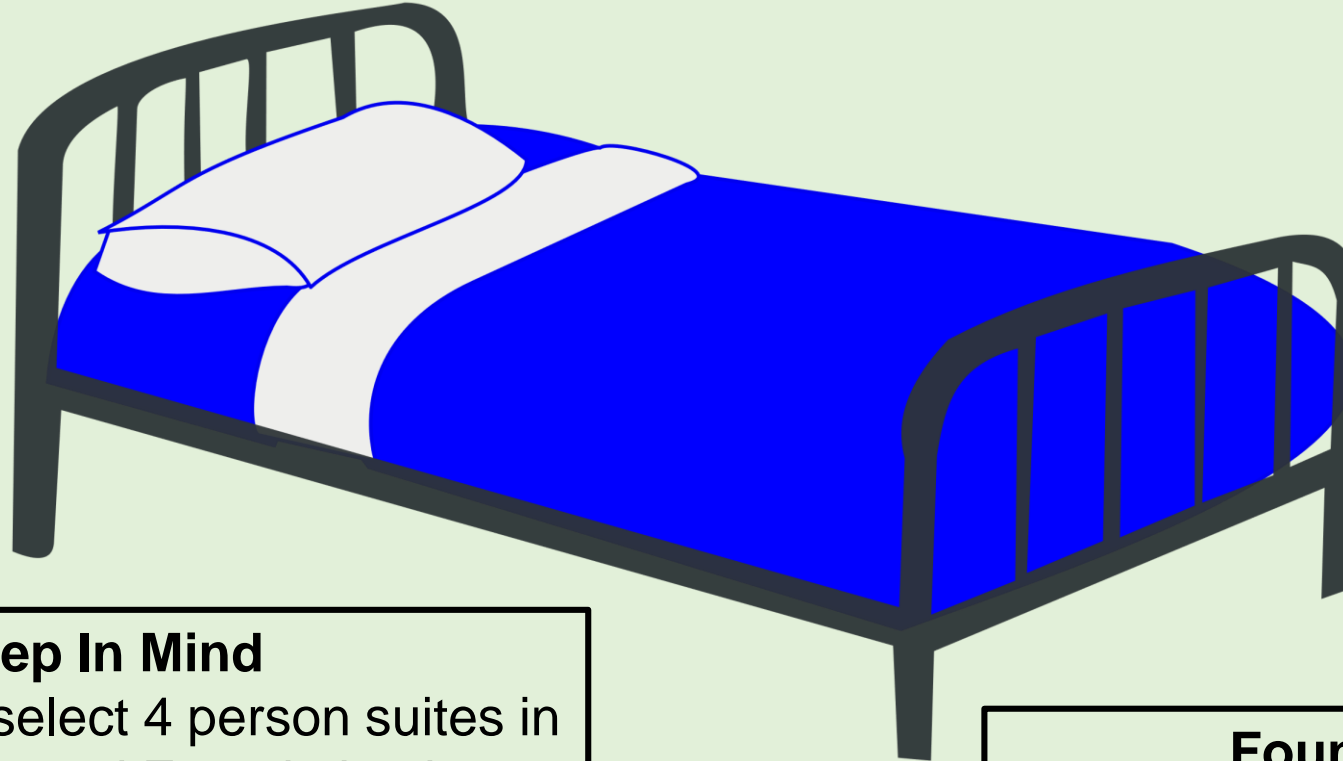

# TYPES OF ROOMS

## **Towers Hall**

Single: 1 occupant  
Double: 2 occupants  
Suite: 2 bedrooms  
with a common  
space; 4 occupants



## **Guild Hall**

Suite: 2 bedrooms  
joined by a shared  
bathroom; 4  
occupants

## **Keep In Mind**

Students must select 4 person suites in  
Guild, Towers, and Foundation in a  
complete group of 4.

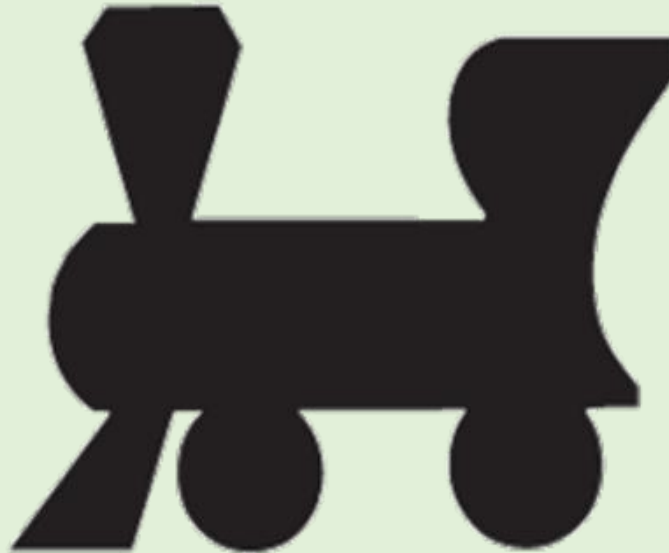
Students can select doubles in Towers  
as a group of 2 or will be consolidated  
with another solo applicant.

## **Foundation Hall**

Suite: 2 bedrooms; 4 occupants  
Seahawk Suite: 2 bedrooms with a  
common space; 4 occupants

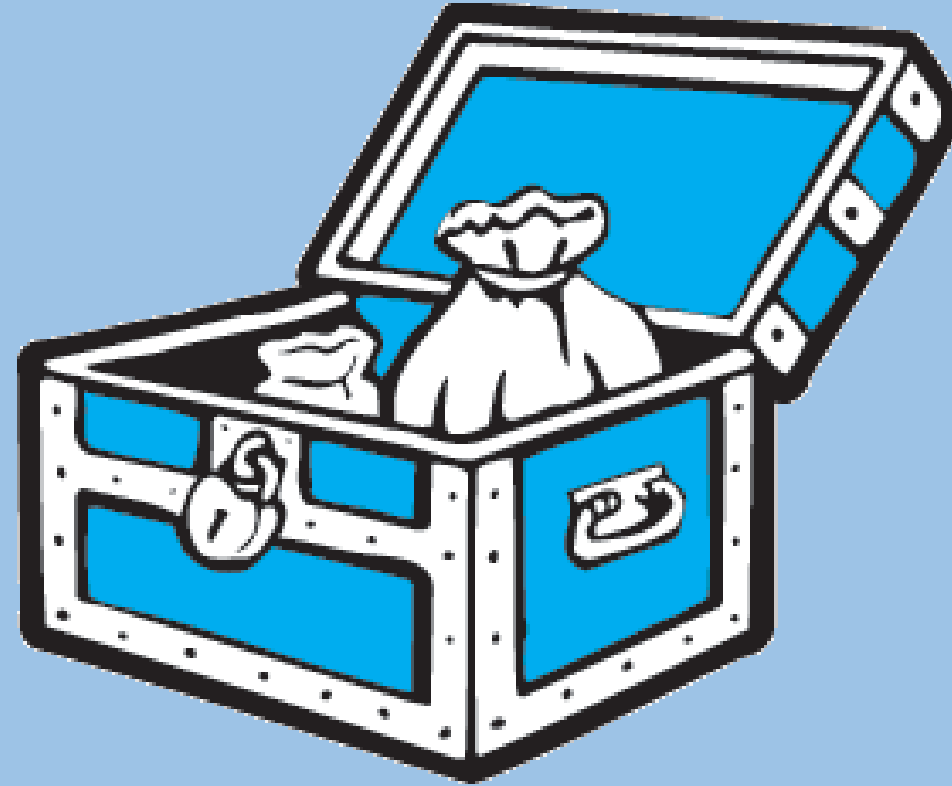

# GROUP TYPES

- *Double or 4 person suite (same class year):* Pick on your appropriate rising class year night
- *Double or 4 person suite (different class year):* Pick on your appropriate mixed night
- *Incomplete Group:* If you are missing one individual to fill a double, you will be allowed to pick a room, but you will be consolidated. *Suites cannot pick without complete groups.*
- *Single:* You will pick on last chance lotto selection

# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What if I nor my groupmates can go to our designated selection night?

*Send a proxy in your place! The proxy can be anyone at Wagner College who is a full time student. Make sure your proxy has your completed Housing Group Form on selection night. Room selections proxy make are final and cannot be changed. If you can't find a proxy, ResEd will help you out!*

What if I am in a Themed Community, have a medical accommodation, or in Greek Housing?

*You do not go to housing selection! You will receive emails regarding these housing options.*

What if I am the winner of the guaranteed room contest?

*Winners of guaranteed suites/rooms will select rooms prior to housing selection evenings.*
